

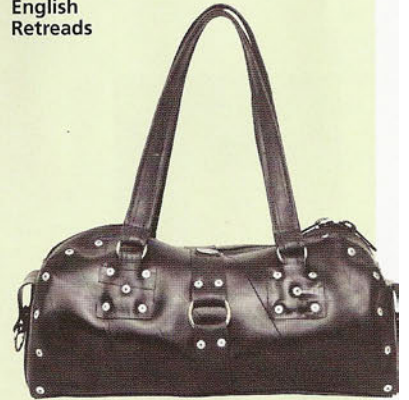
IN THE BAG

Balancing style with substance, this collection of eco-conscious clutches and totes proves that being earth-friendly can be stylish, too. **English Retreads** has reinvented the wheel with the Large Beetle bag (\$199). Made from recycled truck inner tubes and lined with recycled PET material, this biker-inspired bag makes even tough girls feel down-to-earth. From rubbish to the red carpet, **Nahui Ollin's** Envelope Clutch (\$99) is a shining example of eco glam created with repurposed candy wrappers from factories in Mexico. The Carmen clutch (\$79) from **Mad Imports** is handmade in Madagascar with sustainably sourced raffia and carved wood from managed forests. **Raw Bags** heads back to nature with the small Wheat Pandan Tote (\$80). Constructed from woven pandan leaves with a wood handle, the tote makes a big impression with minimal impact. Using a signature combination of PVC-free faux leather and custom-printed ultrasuede, Lily (\$120) by **Amykathryn** is a flirty and functional carryall tote with an animal- and earth-friendly philosophy. Northern Creations, a knitting cooperative from rural Peru, creates **Autonomie Project's** new collection of hand-crocheted bags. Comprised of 25 mothers, the group makes vegan, fair trade and eco-friendly bags like the Button Clutch (\$45) to provide better lives for their children and community. Cropping up for fall, the Harvest Collection by **Keen** is designed around repurposed materials. With the shell, lining and bottom made from reclaimed rice bags, Keen's Parisi (\$40) gives used rice bags a second life. —*Meaghan Kerins*

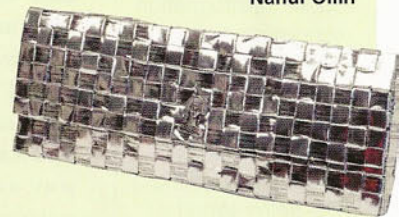
